Far West Family Services is located in the University Business Center which is in the same building as Yinzi's Kitchen and the AMC Seattle 10 movie theater (formerly Sundance). The office suites are located on the 3rd floor. You do not need to check in with the receptionist, but take a seat in the waiting room and Janine will come out and meet you.

Parking Options:

The most convenient parking is in the pay lot across the street (9th) from the building. It is a pay lot managed by Diamond Parking. You can pay with a debit card or the Call to Park app or phone number. The current rate for 2 hours (minimum purchase) is \$8.58.

However, visitors to the Business Center are eligible for one hour of free parking (and a discounted rate for a second hour) in the lot adjacent to the building on the north side. There is an open lot and a parking garage, entered from 47th. (By the corner of 9th and 47th.)

You may park in the lot in front of "Good To Go", or the top two levels of the parking structure, P2 & P3, in any unrestricted stall. (The basement level is for Trader Joe's parking only.)

Decide if you will need one (1) hour of parking or two (2) hours of parking and then follow either of the instructions below. Not both.

One hour of free parking:

1. Park in one of the unrestricted spots
2. Go to the pay station in the parking garage (located by stall #73)
3. Enter license plate, select option 5) and then option 1)
4. Enter code **4500** to register for one hour of free parking

Two hours of parking (current rate \$6.14):

1. Park in one of the unrestricted spots
2. Go to the pay station in the parking garage (located by stall #73)
3. Enter license plate, select option 5) and then option 2)
4. Enter code **4501** to register and pay for a total of two hours of parking.

Parking for those with a disability:

For those with a Washington State Disabled Parking Privilege plate or placard, you may park in the lot directly across the street, in any of the handicapped stalls. Parking is free with plate or placard displayed.
